1. Call to Order at 7:05p

2. Approval of November Meeting Minutes

Lorin Umbel made motion to approve November Meeting Minutes, motion was seconded and approved by all present.

3. Booster President's Message – Steve Schuck Team Snap enrollment is in process. Parents need to be invited to join by their athletes. Teams are using it as follows: Girls Basketball coach said that team snap will be her communication tool as will Girls JV Basketball team. Varsity boys will work with Doug; Coach Breslaw added training schedule; Track has not been using it; Wrestling is working with parents. Josh Klotz interjected that many do not know how to use Team Snap and that some parents were wondering whether they have to pay \$40 to sign up. In fact, non-members can use Team Snap as well if invited by their athlete. Athletes are invited by coach or delegate. Coach enters practice schedule and other information into Team Snap. Team Snap also works well with off season organizational aspects like signing up for summer camp etc. That would be in off season team tab. Once signed up, parent information migrates from off season to next season easily.

Klotz agreed that football's booster donations could be higher but he sees the role of the team as building community. His athletes often cannot pay but the team's success brings people to games where they buy concessions. Success also generates excitement about RM sports. Klotz is communicating importance of boosters with parents. However, Schuck said, coaches' messages are important and Boosters sees differences in results depending on coaches' message even in same sport.

Team Snaps builds communications channels to parents. At the moment, Boosters is able only to talk to a small percentage of parents. Coach Klotz would like to be notified earlier when concession stand coverage is lacking. Especially for JV games. He would like to have more people come to games. Boosters would like to be doing more community building events but are hampered by lack of communication channels.
